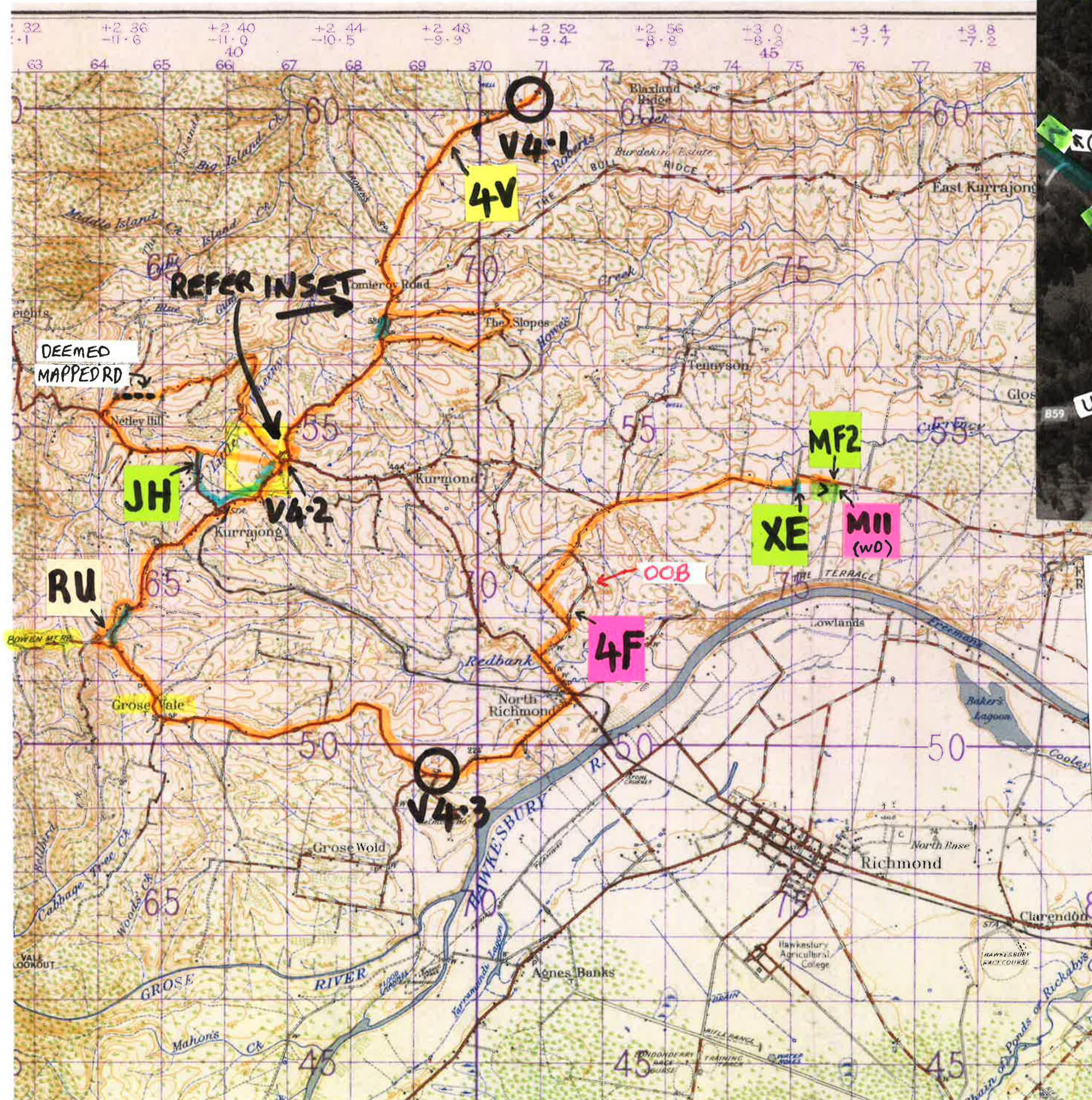

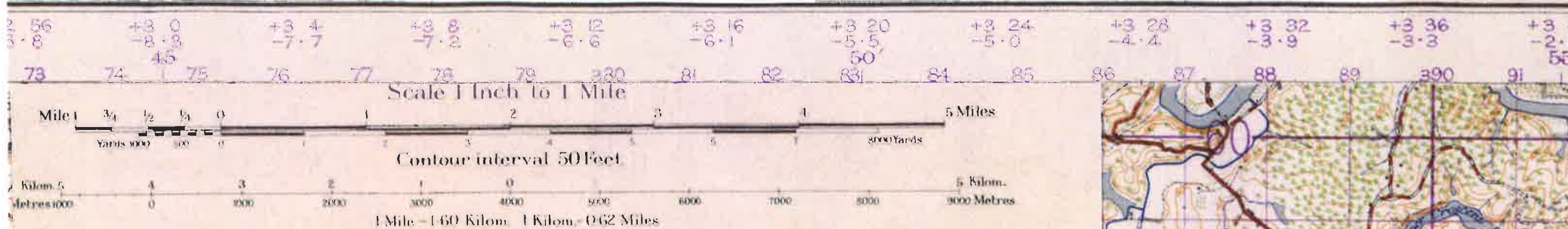


**WILBERFORCE**

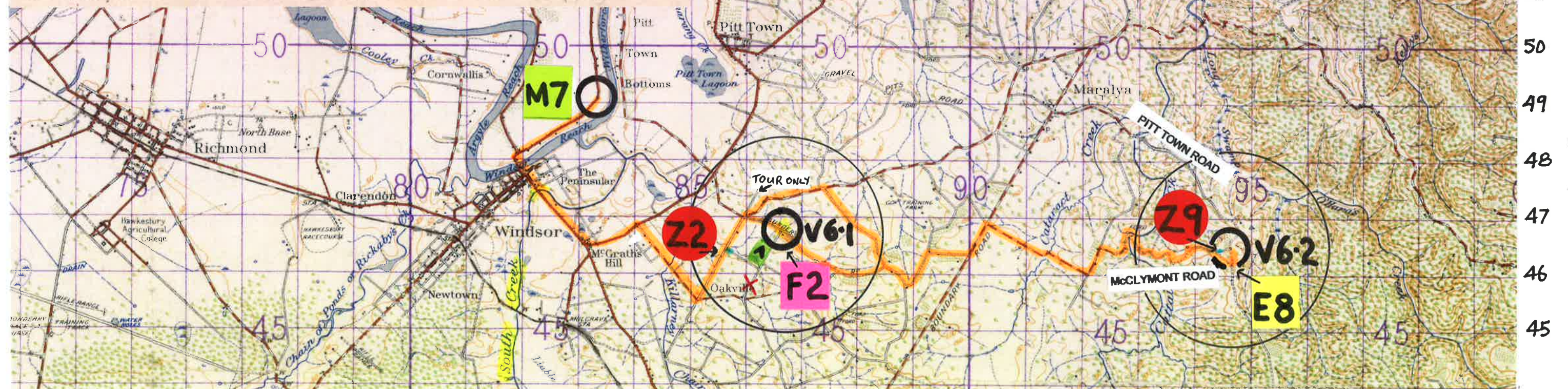
