A Club Social (Non-Competitive) Event - Motorsport Australia Permit No. 221/211/03

The Somewhere Start: Glenorie Bakery, 930 Old Northern Road, Glenorie (carparking is around corner in Post Office Road or in Woolworths's carpark opposite). Food & coffee available at bakery.

Time: First car departs Glenorie Bakery sometime after 8.30 am.

The Somewhere Finish: Picnic Lunch at Mount Penang Gardens, 16 The Avenue, Kariong.

Distance: 176km – no unsealed roads.

Expected Driving Time: Sometime between 4-5 hours – we hope that all stragglers and coffee stoppers should be at the picnic ground sometime before 2pm at the latest.

Fuel: There is no fuel available at the start. Please fill up on the way at Dural where there are some stations along Old Northern Rd. Fuel available on route at 62 km, 154 km and near finish at 176 km.

Format: Fully route charted instructions provided. However, for someone who wants to try a bit of a navigational challenge, maps and some easy mapping instructions will also be provided just for fun. There will not be any visual route checks, course checkers or sweep cars – you're on your own.

Questions: Being a social fun run we can give you someptuous questions, even cryptic ones!

Scavenger Hunt: We may even throw in a list of “special somethings” that you may bring or collect along the way for a bit more fun – things that you might normally take on an Alpine Classic perhaps.

Food and Drinks: **BYO Everything and Something** including rug, chairs, table if required. There are BBQ facilities, toilets, and a café at the Mount Penang Gardens.

Vehicle Eligibility: The fun run is open to all registered vehicles – somewhat classic, older vehicles encouraged, of course. The event will be listed on the club calendar and therefore qualifies as a club event for historic plates. No scrutineering required. Entrants must comply with all road rules.

Driver/Crew Eligibility: Any participants who intend to drive in the event must have a valid driving licence. Motorsport Australia (MA) licences are not required for the event. All drivers and crew are required to comply with the NSW Covid-19 Health Orders applicable at the time of the event.

Don't want to drive the 176 km?: Drive up the M1 Motorway to the Gosford exit and just join someone, somewhere at the picnic. You can also cut and run at 112 km and 146 km.

Want more corners on the way home?: Take the Old Pacific Highway from **Somersby** to Berowra.

Cost: \$00.00 – doesn't get better than that.

Entries: Entries open sometime from now and close sometime before the event and will be limited to some number of vehicles. Send completed entry form to phillstead22@gmail.com - 0412805122.
